
To ensure that the perfect sectional will fit, compare the dimensions of your space with the style you're considering. You'll also need to check the areas it will pass through to get there.

MEASURE YOUR SOFA OR SECTIONAL

Jot down the width (w), depth (d), and height (h) of the sectional you're considering, including the height of the legs if applicable.








MEASURE YOUR SPACE

Using those dimensions, mark the area where you'd like to place the sectional with painter's tape. Keep in mind that you'll need to leave enough space around the sofa/sectional to walk easily through the room.

MEASURE ALL DOORWAYS, PASSAGES & STAIRWELLS

Measure the interior height and width of the delivery pathway, including doorways, hallways and staircases. The diagonal depth must be less than the width. If you live in a building with an elevator, this includes the elevator's opening and distance between walls. Also consider architectural details and low-hanging light fixtures.
